BUDGET AMENDMENT #1
Ordinance 09-24-20-01

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annual budget and amendment thereof:

Whereas the County of Bourbon has realized unbudgeted receipts from Federal Reimbursement of expenditures related to COVID-19.

Be it ordained by the Fiscal Court of County of Bourbon, Commonwealth of Kentucky:

Section One: The budget for fiscal year 2020-2021 is amended to:

A. Increase the receipts of the 07-Federal Grant Fund by \$673,706.00 to include unbudgeted receipts from: Federal Reimbursement for Covid Exp, account 07-4503 by \$673,706.00.

B. Increase expenditure account: Reserve for Transfer, account 07-9200-999 by \$673,706.00.

Section Two: The amounts adjusting the receipt and expenditure accounts in Section One are for governmental purposes.

SEWER LINES

Your city is conducting

Work crews will be in your area starting 10/12/2020. A "SMOKE TEST" survey will assist our inspection crews in locating breaks and defects in our sewer system. The smoke you see coming from the vent stacks on houses or holes in the ground is NON-TOXIC, NON-STAINING, HAS NO ODOR, WHITE TO GRAY IN COLOR AND CREATES NO FIRE HAZARD.

The smoke should not enter your home unless you have defective plumbing or dried up drain traps.

It is advisable for the home owner to pour a gallon of water into each floor drain prior to our testing. If smoke enters your home there is good reason to assume that dangerous sewer gases may also be entering your home or business. You should evacuate immediately and notify our work crews. If you are not home and discover smoke when you return, please call us at 859-987-2116.
