#### NOTICE OF ADOPTION AND SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE The County of Boyle, Kentucky (the "County"), hereby gives public notice that at a meeting of

the Fiscal Court held in the Boyle County Fiscal Court Building, 321 West Main Street, Danville, Kentucky 40422, on May 27, 2025, at 9:00 a.m., EST (local time), an Ordinance (the "Ordinance") identified by its title and summarized as follows was given second reading and adopted by the Fiscal Court of the County, as provided by KRS 67.077 and KRS 103.210: AN ORDINANCE OF THE FISCAL COURT OF THE COUNTY OF BOYLE, KENTUCKY,

AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$130,000,000 AGGREGATE PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF HOSPITAL REVENUE AND REFUNDING REVENUE BONDS IN ONE OR MORE SERIES; AUTHORIZING THE LOAN OF THE PROCEEDS OF THE BONDS TO EPHRAIM MCDOWELL HEALTH, INC. FOR THE PURPOSE OF FINANCING ALL OR A PORTION OF THE (I) THE ACQUISITION, CONSTRUCTION, INSTALLATION, AND EQUIPPING OF HOSPITAL AND HEALTHCARE FACILITIES AND IMPROVEMENTS OWNED BY EPHRAIM MCDOWELL HEALTH, INC. AND ITS AFFILIATES (COLLECTIVELY, "EPHRAIM MCDOWELL"), (II) REFUNDING HOSPITAL REVENUE AND REFUNDING REVENUE BONDS PREVIOUSLY ISSUED BY THE COUNTY FOR THE BENEFIT OF EPHRAIM MCDOWELL, (III) REFUNDING OTHER INDEBTEDNESS OF EPHRAIM MCDOWELL, AND (IV) PAYING COSTS OF ISSUANCE OF THE BONDS; APPROVING THE SALE OF EACH SERIES OF THE BONDS TO THE PURCHASERS THEREOF; AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION AND DELIVERY OF A LOAN AGREEMENT, A BOND INDENTURE, AND A BOND PURCHASE AGREEMENT GOVERNING THE SALE AND ISSUANCE OF EACH SERIES OF THE BONDS AND THE USE OF THE PROCEEDS THEREOF; APPROVING ONE OR MORE PRELIMINARY OFFICIAL STATEMENTS AND FINAL OFFICIAL STATEMENTS TO BE UTILIZED IN THE SALE OF THE BONDS; AUTHORIZING FURTHER ACTION BY COUNTY OFFICIALS AND DIRECTING THEM TO TAKE ALL NECESSARY ACTION TO EFFECTUATE THE INTENT AND PURPOSE OF THIS ORDINANCE.

SUMMARY

The Ordinance authorizes the issuance of one or more series of its hospital revenue and refunding revenue bonds in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$130,000,000 (the "Bonds") for the purposes of (i) financing the costs of the acquisition, construction, installation, and equipping of improvements and renovations to Ephraim McDowell Regional Medical Center; (ii) refunding the outstanding County of Boyle, Kentucky, Hospital Refunding Revenue Bond, Series 2014A (Ephraim McDowell Health Obligated Group) and County of Boyle, Kentucky, Hospital Revenue Bond, Series 2014B (Ephraim McDowell Health Obligated Group) in advance of maturity; (iii) refinancing a loan incurred with the United States Department of Agriculture to finance improvements to Ephraim McDowell James B. Haggin Hospital; (iv) paying costs and fees related to the termination or modification of certain existing hedging transactions related to the foregoing; (v) funding reasonably required reserve or debt service funds; and (vi) paying costs of issuance of the Bonds.

Each series of the Bonds will be issued in accordance with a Loan Agreement (the "Loan Agreement") by and between the County and Ephraim McDowell Health, Inc. ("Ephraim McDowell"), a Kentucky nonprofit corporation and a Bond Indenture (an "Indenture") from the County to the Trustee identified

The Ordinance authorizes and approves the execution and delivery of (i) a Loan Agreement for each series of Bonds, pursuant to which Ephraim McDowell will make loan payments directly to the Trustee on behalf of the County to pay the such series of Bonds as authorized by KRS 103.200 to 103.285, inclusive (the "Act"); (ii) an Indenture for each series of Bonds, which sets forth the terms and conditions upon which such series of the Bonds are to be secured, issued, and outstanding; (iii) a Bond Purchase Agreement for each series of Bonds; (iv) an Official Statement (and Preliminary Official Statement, if applicable) for each series of Bonds; (v) an inducement and indemnification agreement or letter for each series of Bonds from Ephraim McDowell to the County and the bond underwriters; and (vi) various related documents.

In accordance with the Act, each series of the Bonds will constitute special and limited obligations of the County payable solely and only from payments made by Ephraim McDowell under the applicable Loan Agreement and other collateral of Ephraim McDowell and its affiliates and will not constitute a debt or pecuniary obligation of the County or be payable from any County funds or

The Ordinance authorizes the County Judge/Executive and other County officials to take any other necessary actions and to execute on behalf of the County any necessary or appropriate documents in order to issue and deliver the Bonds.
