was presented after the fact, and the commission voted to rescind last week's motion.

The new quote from Scotty's Contracting & Stone was for \$39,970.92 to repave the portion of the Clarkson walking track going around the baseball fields (about half of a mile).

Clarkson Mayor Bonnie Henderson said the other half of the walking track

on the soccer field side can wait to be repaved for a few years.

After discussion, the city commission voted to accept the \$39,970.92 quote from Scotty's and to pay \$8,000 of that amount from the Clarkson Park fundraising fund and the remainder of the balance from the city's general fund.

Officials expect the resurfacing work to be done within the next few weeks.

"We're excited about it," said City Commissioner Tammy Schultz.
