The Rating Score of the establishment is determined by subtracting weighted point values of noted violations from 100. Unannounced inspections observe the overall operation, including food source and protection; personnel; food equipment & utensils; maintenance of water and sewage systems; garbage and refuse disposal; insect, rodent and animal control; and storage of toxic items, among others. Critical violations are items which, if uncorrected, carry the potential to be an imminent threat to the public's health. These items must be corrected in a time designated by the health department not to exceed 10 days.

was presented after the fact, and the commission voted to rescind last week's motion.

The new quote from Scotty's Contracting & Stone was for \$39,970.92 to repave the portion of the Clarkson walking track going around the baseball fields (about half of a mile).

Clarkson Mayor Bonnie Henderson said the other half of the walking track

on the soccer field side can wait to be repaved for a few years.

After discussion, the city commission voted to accept the \$39,970.92 quote from Scotty's and to pay \$8,000 of that amount from the Clarkson Park fundraising fund and the remainder of the balance from the city's general fund.

Officials expect the resurfacing work to be done within the next few weeks.

"We're excited about it," said City Commissioner Tammy Schultz.
