Dual Credit courses are offered at various

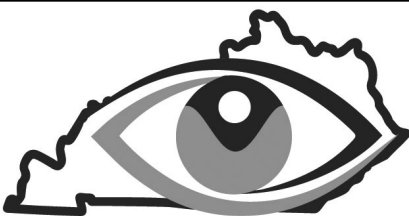
locations, including area high schools, area technology centers, MCTC and online.
