INDICTMENTS

The latest session of the Taylor County grand jury resulted in indictments being returned in several pending criminal cases.

Indictments are formal charges and not proof of guilt. The grand jury findings indicate enough evidence exists to continue with legal proceedings. All suspects are considered innocent unless proven

- Jessica Gaddis, Campbellsville: Charged with trafficking in a controlled substance, fentanyl, while in possession of a firearm; first-degree trafficking in a controlled substance, methamphetamine, while in possession of a firearm; possession of a handgun by a convicted felon; second-degree possession of a controlled substance, buprenorphine, while in possession of a firearm; third-degree possession of a controlled substance, drug unspecified, while in possession of a firearm; possession of drug paraphernalia; public intoxication; and second-degree persistent felony offender. Bond set at \$100,000.
- Stephon Boyd, Columbia: Charged with trafficking in marijuana, second or subsequent offense, while in possession of a firearm; possession of a firearm

by a convicted felon; possession of drug paraphernalia; second offense operating a motor vehicle while under the influence with aggravating circumstances; ignition interlock use violation; failure of non-owner operator to maintain required insurance; operating on a suspended or revoked license; speeding 15 mph or more over the limit; possession of an open alcohol beverage container in a motor vehicle; and first-degree persistent felony offender. 
