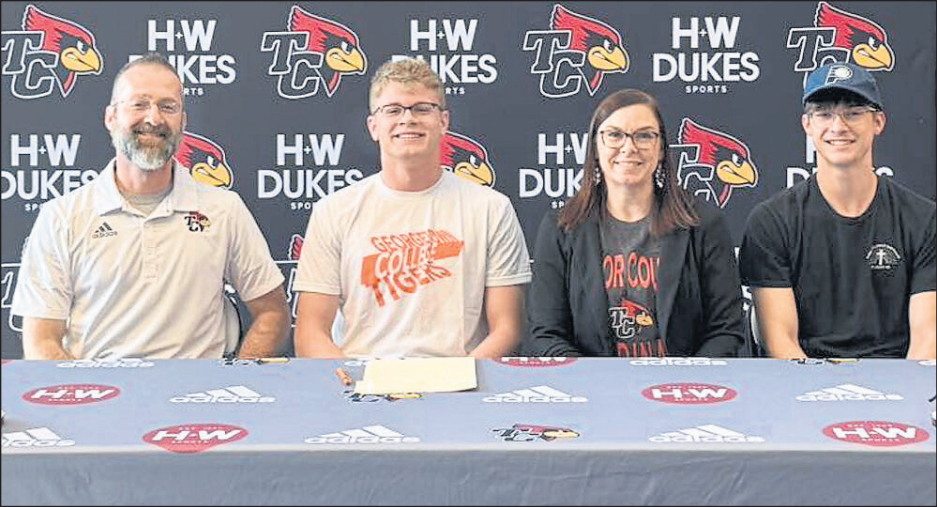

**Cardinals near 20-win season**

Taylor County scored first and never trailed, topping Central Hardin 5-3 in a non-district game on Monday, April 28. Trailing 5-0, Central Hardin did manage to push across three runs during its sixth at-bat. Gabe Cole started on the mound for Taylor County and earned the win. Cole pitched five innings and recorded four strikeouts. JT Johns followed Cole on the mound and pitched two innings in relief for the Cardinals. Johns posted two strikeouts. Kellen Brandenburg

started on the mound for Central Hardin and suffered the loss. Brandenburg pitched the first four innings for the Cardinals. Following Brandenburg, Reece Cowley and Chase Price each pitched one inning in relief for the Bruins. Taylor County plated five runs on five hits. Multiple Taylor County players delivered at the plate, including Grayson Kearney (one hit, one RBI), Reece Vaughn (one hit, one RBI), Layken Lyons (one hit), Silas Young (one hit), Cole McLean (one hit) and Austin Garrett (one RBI). Kearney, Young and Vaughn each doubled for the Cardinals. Central Hardin plated three runs on eight hits. Brandenburg (two hits), Cowley (one hit), Chase Higdon (two hits, two RBIs), Caleb Irwin (one hit), Logan Robertson (one hit) and Devin Hubbard (one hit) each delivered offensively for the Bruins. Entering its Wednesday night showdown with Campbellsville for the 20th District regular-season title, the Cards were 19-3 on the season with five home games left before the district tournament.

Notice is hereby given that Green Taylor Water District ("District") plans to file with the Public Service Commission on or before May 1 2025 to adjust certain non-recurring charges. The proposed effective date is June 2, 2025. The proposed changes are as follows:

- Currently, Green-Taylor Water District assesses a \$1.50 fee for credit/debit card transactions. Green-Taylor Water District is proposing to change its tariff to state the following: "When a customer makes a payment by credit card or debit card, the processor (not the District) will assess a convenience fee for providing this service. Prior to processing the transaction, the customer will be informed of the fee amount." The amount of the convenience fee assessed by the processor will be actual cost."
- Green-Taylor Water District's customers mail in their meter readings monthly. Green-Taylor is requesting as part of its leak adjustment policy that to be eligible for a leak adjustment the customer must submit actual monthly meter readings to the District so that the customers adjustment is based on actual usage and not estimated readings.
- Green-Taylor Water District is proposing to change delinquent penalty from the 20th day of the month following the month of water usage to the 15th day of the month following the month of water usage.
- Green-Taylor Water District is proposing to change the disconnect date for nonpayment from the 15th day of the month following the month the bill is received to payment must be received by end of business day on the 20th day of the month following the month of water usage or customer will be subject to disconnect on the 21st.
- Green-Taylor Water District proposes to add ACH-Bank Draft/Automatic policy to its tariff. Where the customer can elect to have their bill paid by bank draft to the District at no charge to the customer. The ACH-Bank Draft will be withdrawn on the 10 of each month.

If the PSC does not receive a written request for intervention within thirty (30) days of the initial publication or mailing of notice, the PSC may take final action on the tariff filing.
