Request for Bids (RFB): LED Lighting Retrofit Project

Project Title: SHPO-Compliant LED Lighting Retrofit

Location: Wolfe County Courthouse 16 Court Street Campton, KY 41301

Bid Due Date: August 12th, 2025 1:00pm

Issuing Agency: Wolfe County Fiscal Court

**1. Project Overview**

Wolfe County Fiscal Court is soliciting bids from qualified contractors for the retrofit of interior and/or exterior lighting with energy-efficient LED fixtures in accordance with a final design approved by the State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO). The retrofit must preserve the historic integrity of the facility while meeting all modern energy and safety codes.

This project is funded in part by federal sources and must comply with both the Build America, Buy America Act (BABA) and the Davis-Bacon Act (DBA).

**2. Scope of Work**

The general scope includes:

- Removal and safe disposal of existing lighting fixtures and components
- Installation of SHPO-approved LED fixtures and lighting controls
- Minor electrical modifications as needed for retrofit compatibility
- Coordination with historic preservation guidelines to avoid damage or alteration to protected features
- Testing, commissioning, and documentation of installed systems
- Compliance with energy efficiency standards and local electrical codes

**Note:** Contractors must contact the issuing agency for complete project specifications, site conditions, and fixture schedules.

**3. Compliance Requirements**

**3.1 Build America, Buy America (BABA) Requirements**

This project is subject to the Build America, Buy America (BABA) provisions under the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA).

All iron, steel, manufactured products, and construction materials used must be produced in the United States unless an applicable waiver is granted. This includes lighting fixtures, mounting hardware, and electrical components.

**Bidders must:**

- Certify their compliance with BABA
- Provide documentation confirming U.S. origin of materials
- Ensure subcontractors and suppliers comply with BABA rules

**3.2 Davis-Bacon Act (DBA) Requirements**

The project is also governed by the Davis-Bacon Act (DBA). All laborers and mechanics must be paid prevailing wages as determined by the U.S. Department of Labor for the local area and type of construction work.

**Requirements include:**

- Use of prevailing wage rates
- Submission of certified payrolls
- Compliance by subcontractors
- Accurate labor classification and time tracking

**4. Contractor Qualifications**

To be eligible, bidders must provide:

- Valid contractor license in the project jurisdiction
- Experience with similar lighting retrofit and SHPO-sensitive projects
- Proof of insurance and bonding (see Section 5)
- Documentation of BABA and DBA compliance experience
- Three references from comparable retrofit or historic property projects

**5. Insurance and Bonding Requirements**

Contractors must carry the following minimum coverage:

**Insurance:**

- General Liability: \$1,000,000 per occurrence / \$2,000,000 aggregate
- Auto Liability: \$1,000,000 combined single limit
- Workers’ Compensation: As required by law
- Employer’s Liability: \$500,000 per accident

**Bonds:**

- Bid Bond: 5% of bid total
- Performance Bond: 100% of contract value
- Payment Bond: 100% of contract value

**6. Bid Submission Requirements**

**All bids must include:**

- Company background and qualifications
- Itemized cost proposal
- Draft project schedule
- Statement of compliance with BABA and DBA
- Proof of insurance and bonding
- List of key personnel and subcontractors
- Three references from similar projects
