

Bidders must:

- Provide documentation confirming U.S. origin of materials
- Ensure subcontractors and suppliers comply with BABA rules

3.2 Davis-Bacon Act (DBA) Requirements

The project is also governed by the Davis-Bacon Act (DBA). All laborers and mechanics must be paid prevailing wages as determined by the U.S. Department of Labor for the local area and type of construction work.

Requirements include:

- Use of prevailing wage rates
- Submission of certified payrolls
- Compliance by subcontractors
- · Accurate labor classification and time tracking

4. Contractor Qualifications

To be eligible, bidders must provide:

- Valid contractor license in the project jurisdiction
- Experience with similar lighting retrofit and SHPO-sensitive projects
- Proof of insurance and bonding (see Section 5)
- Documentation of BABA and DBA compliance experience
- Three references from comparable retrofit or historic property projects

5. Insurance and Bonding Requirements

Contractors must carry the following minimum coverage: Insurance:

- Auto Liability: \$1,000,000 combined single limit
- · Workers' Compensation: As required by law •Employer's Liability: \$500,000 per accident
- Bonds:

- · Bid Bond: 5% of bid total
- Performance Bond: 100% of contract value
- Payment Bond: 100% of contract value
