After long wait, UK lands Momcilovic

LEXINGTON – Milan Momcilovic, the top available player remaining in the college basketball transfer portal, chose UK over Louisville and Arizona on Monday night.

The 6-foot-8 Momcilovic played for Iowa State last season where he led college basketball in three-point shooting with a 48.7 percentage on 7.5 attempts per game. His coming vaults UK back into the position of national contender under Mark Pope, who enters season three as the head coach.

"I think Kentucky would be a good fit," Momcilovic told the Lexington Herald-Leader last month. "I obviously went against Pope at BYU his first year (in the Big 12), and I loved how his team played. I think we went 1-1 against them, but they killed us at their place, because they fly the ball up the court and shoot 3s. I really like the way they play."

Momcilovic's style fits Kentucky with his ability to shoot from beyond the perimeter.

"Kentucky last year, he didn't have enough shooters around him to really coach, I feel like, the way he wanted," he said at the time. "But I think — if I were to choose Kentucky — that would be a good fit for me. I feel like I'd be a great player for him, and he'd be a good coach for me."
