## Application period open for KFB scholarship program

The Kentucky Farm Bureau post-secondary scholarship program is accepting applications from high school seniors until 11:59 p.m. Feb. 28. Scholarships will be awarded in more

than 50 categories, with some scholarships also available to non-traditional students. Funds may be applied to tuition, housing, books or other educational expenses. To be eligible, an applicant must be the child of a KFB member and

complete high school within the year they apply.

In 2025, KFB awarded 601 Kentucky students a total of \$810,150 in scholarships at both the state and county level. The program is made possible through a partnership of the KFB

Education Foundation and county Farm Bureaus.

"These scholarships help remove barriers for students who are working hard to build their future," Eddie Melton, KFB president, said in the deadline announcement. "By investing in their

education, we're investing in Kentucky agriculture, our rural communities and the next generation who will help carry our way of life forward."
